THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT
(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL
SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULA-
TIONS.—

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Self-Employed Persons) Regulation*, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Self-Employed Persons) (Amendment) Regulations 1989. Citation.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended in the following respects — Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

(1) in regulation 2 —

- (a) by the substitution for the words “income group” where they occur in the definition of the expression “income group” of the words “insurable income”;
- (b) by the substitution for the definition of “relevant income” of the following —

“relevant income” means the total weekly earnings on which contributions were paid or credits were awarded or contributions were paid, and credits awarded other than the special transitional credits under regulation 19 of the National Insurance and Social Security (Benefit) Regulations during a specified period divided by the number of weeks in that period;

- (2) in regulation 6, by the deletion of paragraphs (b) and (f) (i) and the renumbering of paragraph (f) (ii) as (f) (i);
- (3) in regulation 7 —
 - (a) by the substitution, in the marginal note, for the words “wage group” of the word “employment”;
 - (b) by the deletion of the words “references to “wage group” shall in relation to self-employed persons be construed as references to “income group” and”;
- (4) in regulation 8, by the deletion of paragraphs (a) and (g);
- (5) by the deletion of the Schedule thereto.
