EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS :----IN

Citation. 1. These Regulations, which amend the Cash on Delivery (Overseas Parcels Post) Regulations*, may be cited as the Cash on Delivery (Ovesreas Parcels Post) (Amendment) Regulations 1989.
