IN EXELCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 42 OF THE FORESTS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS —

1. These Regulations, which amend the Forests Regulations* may be cited as the Forests (Amendment) Regulations, 1979.

Automoment 2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amend ¹⁴ negulation 2 of the following respects — Principal Regulations. (a) by the insertion in paragraph (1) after the word "Sch

Aumendment 3. Regulation 27 (4) of the Principal Regulations is hereb of regulation amended by the substitution for the words "the sum of five doll Principal Regulations. For a band sawmill or for a gang saw Regulations. For a circular sawmill, and five dollars for a saw pit."

of 33. (1) Where any log has been duly measured or sessed for the purposes of royalty and where royalty been paid in respect of the log the forest officer shall –

- (a) mark the log in not less than three places, namely, at the ends and in the middle of the log with such hammer mark as may be authorised by the Conservator;
- (b) affix by the side of each hammer mark the registered serial number of the log; and
- (c) make a record of the particulars of such log in such form as the Conservator shall determine.

(2) Where any log has been duly measured or a, sessed for the purposes of royalty and where royalty has not been paid in respect of the log the forest officer shall-

- (a) affix the registered serial number on the log in not les than three places, namely, at the ends and in the middle;
- (b) not mark the log unless approved by the Conservator with such hammer mark as mentioned in paragraph (1); and
- make a record of the particulars of the log (c) in such form as the Conservator hall determine.

(3) No person shall, except with the written permission of a forest officer, remove any log which has not been hanimer marked and erial numbered from any State forest, depot, beach, awmill, timber yard or landing.".

5. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the addition Addution of regulations after regulation 39 of the following regulations -40 and 41.

"Manner in 40. (1) When logs are presented for measurement for the purposes of royalty the logs shall be displayed in a manner to permit measurem nt piece by piece and the person in pose ssion of the logs shall at hi expense provide all necessary labour for preparing and handling the logs.

> (2) Where sufficient labour is not provided for the satisfactory preparation and handling of timber at the time of measurement, the forest officer may refuse to measure the timber.
