IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 63 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE —

1.(1) These Regulations which amend the Wireless Telegraphy Regulations * may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Amendment) Regulations 1978.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation with.

**Amendment
of Regula-
tion 20.**

2. Regulation 20 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows —

* Cap. 47:01 Subsidiary Legislation.

- (a) by the substitution of the words "\$27.50" for the words "\$5.00" appearing in paragraph (b);
- (b) by the substitution of paragraph (c) for the following paragraph —

"for any other licence pertaining to the subject matter mentioned in the first column of Schedule E the sum specified in that Schedule against the respective subject matter."

Schedule E

3. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended as follows — **Amendment of the Principal Regulations.**

- (a) by the insertion immediately after regulation 45 of the following regulation as regulation 46 —

Telex Fees.

46. The fee in respect of each Telex Station shall be one hundred and fifty dollars per month."

- (b) by the insertion immediately after the new regulation 46 of the following regulation as regulation 47 —

Inspection Fee.

47. The inspection fee in respect of each fixed or mobile station shall be eighty-five dollars per annum."

- (c) by the renumbering of regulations 46, 47 and 48 as regulations 48, 49 and 50 respectively.

4. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion immediately after Schedule D of the following Schedule as Schedule E. **Amendment of the Principal Regulations.**

- (i) an additional H. F. Channel there shall be paid in respect thereof the additional annual fee of \$110.00, if the station is fixed or if mobile, the additional fee of \$55.00;
- (ii) an additional V. H. F. Channel there shall be paid in respect thereof the additional annual fee of \$110.00, if the station is fixed or if mobile, the additional fee of \$55.00;
- (iii) a private radio service and the Guyana Telecommunication Corporation can provide alternative service a waiver fee fixed by the General Manager of the Guyana Telecommunication Corporation shall be levied which shall be computed dependent on the extent of the area to be covered and revenue collectable by the Corporation.
