## REGULATIONS

THE REFERENDUM (AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION) ACT 1978

(No. 9 of 1978)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 6 OF THE REFERENDUM (AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION) ACT 1978, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE:—
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Referendum (Modification of the Representation of the People Act) Regulations 1978.
- 2. For the purposes of the holding of the referendum and subject to regulation 5
  - (a) the Representation of the People Act\* shall, without prejudice to paragraph (b), be construed and have effect as if for every reference therein to an election, an election agent and election day, there were substituted a reference to the referendum, a referendum agent and referendum day, respectively;
  - (b) the provisions of the Representation of the People Act\* and the Elections (Forms for Postal Voters) Regulations,\*\* respectively,

specified in column (1) of the Schedule shall be construed and have effect with the modifications set out in relation thereto in column (2) thereof.

- 3. Without prejudice to regulation 2, the Forms set out in the Schedules to the Representation of the People Act\* and to the Elections (Forms for Postal Voters) Regulations,\*\* respectively, shall for the purpose of the holding of the referendum be adapted, construed and have effect in accordance with the modifications effected by that regulation.
- 4. Without prejudice to any other power conferred upon him by any other law, the Minister may cause to be published in any newspaper circulating in Guyana notices of such matters relating to the referendum as he may think desirable to bring to the attention of persons who are qualified to vote at the referendum.
- 5. Nothing in the foregoing regulations shall render invalid the use for the purpose of carrying out the referendum of any forms or other items of stationery whereon reference is made to the "Chief Referendum Offider" or "National Elections 1973" and such reference shall be construed and have effect as a reference to the Chief Election Officer and to the referendum, respectively.
