Made Under

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE DIRECTOR OF POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the British Postal Order (Amendment) Regulations, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the British Postal Order Regulations* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation is substituted therefor —

“3. The selling price in Guyana of British Postal Orders having the face value indicated in the first column hereunder shall be that set out opposite each denomination in the second column.
