THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER 1964.

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER 1964 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULA-TIONS:-

1.(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Special Service Unit Citation and commence-(Amendment) Regulations 1966 and shall be construed and read with ment. the Special Service Unit Regulations 1964 hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation at the commencement of the Defence Ordinance, 1966.
- Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is hereby of regulation amended by -

11 of princi-pal Regula-

- (a) the deletion of the words "and discipline" from para-tions. graph (3);
- (b) the deletion of the words and figure ", except so far as they conflict, or are inconsistent, with any provisions of the Army Act for the time being applicable by virtue of paragraph (5) of this regulation," from paragraph (4);
- (c) the substitution for paragraph (5) of the following
 - "(5) The provisions of the Defence Ordinance, 1966, and of instruments having the force of law thereunder shall, save as respects matters otherwise regulated by these Regulations, apply in relation to such military force (including the individual members thereof) as aforesaid -
 - (a) as if it were a unit formed under section 6 of that Ordinance; and
 - (b) as if its members had, in pursuance of such provisions, joined the Guyana Defence Force and been assigned the like military ranks therein as they hold by virtue of rules made under this regulation,

and the said provisions shall be construed for the purpose with any necessary adaptations, modifications and qualifications, so, however, that nothing in these Regulations shall be construed to prevent the subordination, whether for purposes of command or otherwise, of members of that military force to other officers and soldiers of the Defence Force, being their superior officers as defined in subsection (2) of section 43 of the said Ordinance, or to members of Her Majesty's forces in pursuance of Part VIII thereof."

Amendment of regulation 31 of principal Regulations.

Paragraph (1) of regulation 31 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after the word "so" of the words "or by enlisting in the Guyana Defence Force".

Amendment of regulation 12 of princi-pal Regulations.

- Regulation 32 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words -
 - (a) "regulation 29 of these Regulations or of" from the proviso to paragraph (1);
 - (b) "regulation 29 of these Regulations or" from paragraph (2).

Amendment of regulation pal Regulations.

Regulation 67 is hereby amended by the substitution for 5. 67 of princi- paragraph (1) of the following –

- "(1) The commanding officer may from time to time, with the approval of the Governor, make rules with regard to all or any of the following matters —
 - (a) the qualifications of persons seeking appointment to the Unit or any part thereof, the form and method of their appointment and their general government with respect to their classification and rank;
 - (b) the procedure for appeal against discharge from the Unit of a subordinate officer or constable."

Amendment of regulation 58 of principal Regula-

- The proviso to regulation 68 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the words "made under them".
- The following provisions of the principal Regulations are Revocation. hereby revoked, that is to say —
 - (a) the definition of "aircraft", "Police Force", "rura! constabulary" and "stores" in paragraph (1) of regulation 2;
 - (b) regulations 3, 5, 6, 9, 29, 30, 35, 36, 37, and 38:

Provided that the revocation of paragraph (2) of regulation 5 and paragraph (2) of regulation 6 shall not have effect in relation to any member of the Unit who was, before the commencement of these Regulations, permitted or required to serve as mentioned in paragraph (1) of either regulation;

(c) Parts IV, V, VIII, IX, X, XII, and XIV.
