GUYANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE
(Chapter 175)

UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Crown Lands (Amendment) Regulations, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Crown Lands Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.
2. The Crown Lands (Amendment) Regulations, 1966, made on the 25th day of July, 1966, and not published in the Gazette are hereby revoked.
3. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby further amended —
 - (a) by the addition of the words “at least one-fifth part of” between the words “required” and “the”;
 - (b) by the substitution of the following for paragraph 5 thereof —
“(5) Where part of the survey fee is deposited in accordance with paragraph (4) of this Regulation, the balance of the said fee shall be paid in four equal annual instalments commencing one year from the date of the application.”
4. Regulation 63 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution in paragraph (1) of the word “forty” for the word “twenty”.
5. Regulation 65 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (8).
6. The following is hereby substituted for the first schedule to the Principal Regulations.

*Provided that where the actual cost of surveying any tract above 15 acres exceeds the amount estimated, the applicant shall be required to pay the excess cost and similarly where the cost is less the applicant shall be entitled to a refund of the difference:

Provided further that an applicant may lodge one-fifth of the survey fees as fixed or as may be estimated by the Commissioner of Lands and Mines upon filing the application, and the remainder in four annual instalments. In the case of an application for a re-survey of any area already held under title or for a sub-division thereof or a redefining of boundaries the applicant must pay the actual cost of survey,

Note (i) The fees for the service of a surveyor and party on survey work in the field shall be at the rate of \$82.39 per day. No fees shall be payable in respect of the days spent in travelling to and from the site of survey where the number of days so spent does not exceed 25 per centum of the number of days spent on work in the field. Any excess in travelling shall be charged for at the rate of \$82.39 a day. The expenses of transportation are not included in the above fees but are payable in addition, together with the cost of wood and iron paals.

(ii) The fees for the services of a surveyor in the office shall be at the rate of \$12.67 a day.

12. For surveying a strip of Crown land for canal or other purposes including diagram or for cutting any boundary line between tracts, or sub-division thereof or redefining boundaries including diagram, if required	*Actual cost
