REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE LABOUR ORDINANCE  
(Chapter 103)

UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hours of Work (Laundries) (Amendment) Regulations, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Hours of Work (Laundries) Regulations, 1962\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and all regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation substituted therefor —

“4. No person to whom these Regulations apply shall be employed in or about the business of a laundry on any Sunday, Christmas Day, the day after Christmas Day if Christmas falls on a Sunday, Eid-Ul-Azha Day, or, if that day is a Sunday, the following day, Phagwah Day, or if that day is a Sunday, the following day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, that is to say the 1st May, or, if that day is a Sunday the following day.”
