REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE ROADS ORDINANCE (Chapter 277).

UNDER SECTION 25 OF THE ROADS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Roads Regulations, Citation 1968, and shall come into operation on the 8th day of December, 1968. mencement.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —

- "autocycle" means a motor cycle constructed so as to be propellable by means of pedals when its motor is not in use;
- "road" means the distance from a point on the road known as the Atkinson/Mackenzie Highway approximately 3.23 miles north of Kuru Kuru bridge (that is to say approximately 8^{1/2} miles from the junction of the said Highway with the East Bank Public Road) and extending along the said Highway to a point approximately 0.49 miles south of Bannia bridge;
- "ticket" means any document issued to the driver of a vehicle in acknowledgement of the payment by him of the amount prescribed by regulation 3 of these Regulations;
- "toll station" means the crection nearest to an extremity of the road and constructed and maintained by the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer for the purpose of collecting the charges prescribed by regulation 3 of these Regulations for the passage of vehicles along the road;
- "vehicle" does not include any vehicle being used in the service of the Crown nor a bicycle.

(2) In these Regulations, the expressions motor vehicle, goods vehicle, motor bus, motor car, motor cycle, shall be construed in conformity with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance but does not include reference to an invalid carriage within the meaning of that Ordinance

3. There shall be paid at the toll station by the driver of any vehicle referred to in the first column of the schedule to these Regulations for the passage of any such vehicle along the road, the amount specified in the second column of that schedule opposite such reference.

4. A ticket shall be issued at the toll station to the driver of a vehicle upon payment by him of the amount prescribed by regulation 3 of these Regulations.

5. (1) No vehicle shall proceed beyond the extremity of the road without the driver thereof surrendering the ticket at a toll station.

(2) The driver of a vehicle on the road shall, if required by a member of the police force, produce the said ticket for inspection.
