REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (ADAPTATION AND  
MODIFICATION OF LAWS) ACT, 1968.

(No. 16 of 1968).

UNDER SECTION 3(1)(d) OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE  
(ADAPTATION AND MODIFICATION OF LAWS) ACT, 1968, AND  
BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABL-  
ING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING  
REGULATIONS—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the People  
(Adaptation and Modification of Laws) (No. 5) Regulations, 1968, and shall  
be deemed to have come into operation on 15th November, 1968.

2. The following amendments to the Election Regulations, 1964, are  
hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 3 of the Representation of the  
People (Adaptation and Modification of Laws) Act, 1968, that is to say—

- (a) the insertion of the word “commencing” immediately after the  
word “period” in paragraph (1) of regulation 43Q;
- (b) the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end of the  
said paragraph and the addition thereto of the following  
proviso—

“Provided that notwithstanding anything provided by any  
law or specified as aforesaid, but without prejudice to regulation  
4. the execution of the provisions of the following regulations  
of this Part may, in so far as the Chief Election Officer finds  
necessary for the purpose of ensuring the casting of the votes  
of non-resident electors duly delivered to him in accordance with  
these Regulations, be continued and completed after the expira-  
tion of the said period whether it expired during or with election  
day.”; and

- (c) the deletion from paragraph (1) of regulation 67B of the words  
“with reference to election day” and the substitution therefor of  
the words “to be carried out in conformity with regulation  
43Q”.
