GUYANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE STATISTICS ORDINANCE, 1965  
(No. 14 of 1965)

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE STATISTICS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE MINISTER ASSIGNED RESPONSIBILITY FOR STATISTICS:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics, (Consumer Expenditure Census) (Household) Regulations, 1969.
2. In these Regulations —
  - “census” means the census directed to be taken by the Consumer Expenditure Census (Household) Order, 1969;
  - “householder” means any occupier who manages any dwelling house.
3. The particulars to be supplied by a householder or a member of a household, as the case may be, on taking of the census, shall be in respect of the matters specified in regulation 4 of these Regulations and shall be supplied in such form and detail as the Statistician may direct.
4. Every householder, on the taking of the census, shall, when required to do so by the Statistician or any authorised officer, furnish the following information —
  - (a) the name, address, age educational attainment, marital status principal occupation and sex, of any member of his household;
  - (b) the salary, wages, allowances, bonuses, fees, and any other remuneration, received by any member of his household;
  - (c) the expenditure incurred on alcohol, clothing, entertainment, food, fuel, lighting, rent, travel, and other goods and services, by any member of his household;

(d) such other information as the Statistician or authorised officer may consider necessary for the purposes of the census.

Provided that where it is not practicable to obtain from the householder any information required to be furnished in respect of any member of his household, the Statistician or authorised officer shall require that member of the household to furnish the information.
