REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE TIMEHRI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ORDINANCE (Chapter 282)

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE TIMEHRI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ORDINANCE I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Timehri International Airport (Charges) Regulations. 1969, and shall come into operation forthwith.

2. In these Regulations, "the Airport" means the Timehri International Airport.

3. There shall be charged and collected a fee of twenty-five cents for every person entering that part of the Terminal Building at the Airport known as the Viewing Gallery.

4. (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this regulation, there shall be charged and collected a fee of fifty cents for every person entering the dining room in the Terminal Building at the Airport.

(2) This regulation shall not apply to -

- (a) persons employed in or about the Airport;
- (b) passengers; and
- (c) members of the crew of an aircraft.

5. There shall be charged and collected from the driver of every motor vehicle parked at the Terminal Building at the Airport at the places appointed by the Director of Civil Aviation the following fees —

For every motor vehicle (other than a motor bus or motor lorry). .25 cents for a period of one hour or part thereof and thereafter 50 cents for a period of twelve hours or part thereof.

For every motor bus or motor lorry. .\$1.00 for every hour with a maximum of \$10.00 for every period of twelve hours.
