REGULATIONS

THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, 1967
(No. 24 of 1967)

UNDER SECTION 19 OF THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, 1967,
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE
MINISTER:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Registration (Residents) (Remuneration of Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the National Registration (Residents) (Remuneration of Officers) Regulations, 1968,* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and all amendments thereto.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 6A of the following regulations —

“6B. On the completion of his work in connection with the distribution of identification cards to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Registration, there shall be paid to —

(a) a registrar the sum of \$250.00;

(b) a deputy registrar and a clerical assistant the sum of \$100.00, respectively.

6C. For the performance of her functions in connection with the preparation of lists of persons whose names appear in the divisional registers, a typist shall be paid at the rate of four cents for each name typed by her on such lists.”.
