Made Under

THE DEFENCE ORDINANCE, 1966, AND THE BRITISH GUIANA
(SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER, 1964.

UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE DEFENCE ORDINANCE, 1966, SECTION 2
OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER,
1964, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER
POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE
FOLLOWING REGULATIONS :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the Defence (Officers) Regulations, 1967, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects —

- (a) by renumbering paragraph (2) as paragraph (3); and
- (b) by the insertion therein of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) thereof —

“(2) Anything in paragraph (1) of this regulation to the contrary notwithstanding, an officer who has neither completed any such period of service nor attained any such age is prescribed therein may, in special circumstances, be promoted :

Provided that an officer shall not be promoted pursuant to the foregoing provisions of this paragraph of this regulation unless the Defence Board concurs with the recommendation of the Commissions Board.”
