# THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE (Chapter 258)

## UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF THE FOLLOWING REGULA-TIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) Regulations, 1969.

2. All animals and meats and their meat products whether fresh, frozen, chilled or dried, fittings, utensils, pens, crates and other animal containers, hides, skins, horns, hair, wool, dehydrated or fresh blood, bones and bonemeal, tankage, hoofs, fodder, milk and other dairy products, and manure and other animal waste shall not be brought from any part of the area described in the Schedule hereto into any other area of Guyana.

3. The discharge of sweepings, garbage or other waste material from vessels or aircraft arriving from any part of the area described in the Schedule hereto into any other area of Guyana is hereby prohibited.

4. The Chief Agricultural Officer may require the disinfection of footwear of the feet, if footwear is not worn, of all persons entering any other area of Guyana from any part of the area described in the Schedule hereto.

5. All passengers and goods arriving at Timehri International Airport from any part of the area described in the Schedule hereto shall be discharged at a place approved by the Chief Agricultural Officer or any person appointed by him.

6. Any Government Veterinary Officer or any person appointed by the Chief Agricultural Officer may stop any person or vehicle or may board any aircraft ship or other vessel, arriving in any other area of the country from any part of the area described in the Schedule hereto, for the purpose of carrying out such examination as he considers necessary and he may seize or disinfect such articles as he may deem necessary.

7. Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of these Regulations shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

### SCHEDULE

The area bounded as follows -

On the North by the parallel of latitude 5°N, On the South by the boundary between Guyana and Brazil, On the East by the boundary between Guyana and Surinam, On the West by the Ireng and Takatu Rivers.
