REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, 1969 (No. 15 of 1969)

In the exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by sections 13, 16, 17, 18, and 51 of the National Insurance and Social Security Act, 1969, and by virtue and in exercise of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Collection of Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1969 and shall be construed and read as one with the National Insurance and Social Security (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1969, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. Paragraph (2) of regulation 17 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects
 - (a) by substituting a semi-colon for the full stop at the end of paragraph (ii) of the proviso; and
 - (b) by adding the following paragraph thereto -
- "(iii) Christmas bonuses, annual production bonuses, severance payments and terminal gratuities shall not be included in the gross earnings of an insured person."
