# REGULATIONS Made Under

# THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE. (Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDI-NANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT, HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Overtime) Regulations, 1970, and shall be construed and read as one with the Post Office (Overtime) Regulations, 1960\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
  - The Principal Regulations are hereby amended
    - (a) by the substitution for Schedule A thereto of the schedule set out in the First Schedule:

Schedule

- by the insertion in the first and second columns, respectively, of Schedule B thereto, immediately before the particulars relating to the post of "Senior Lineman" of the posts and particulars set out in the Second Schedule: and
- to the extent and in the manner specified in the Third Schedule. (c) Schedule.

Third Schedule.

- The amendments effected by regulation 2 shall be deemed to have come into operation
  - in relation to paragraph (a) of that regulation on the 1st January, 1961;
  - in relation to paragraph (b) of the said regulation, on (b) 1st January, 1962 with respect to the post of Rigger and 1st January, 1964, with respect to the post of Line Supervisor: and
  - in relation to paragraph (c) thereof, on the 1st March, 1967.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations).

The revision in 1961 and 1964 of salaries and wages in the Public Service makes it necessary that the rate of commuted overtime allowances for Postal Employees be revised as the rates presently applicable, are based upon the pre 1961 salaries and wages. It is intended that the revised overtime rates, set out in the first schedule to these regulations, be made applicable as from 1961.
