Validity of A CARICOM Special Visa issued under these Regulations 5. (1) CARICOM shall be valid for multiple entries in Guyana during the period from 15th Special Visa. January 2007 to 15<sup>th</sup> May 2007 or until such extended period. (2)A CARICOM Special Visa issued under these Regulations shall be deemed to be a valid visa under any other written law for entry in Guyana. Form and fee. 6. (1) A CARICOM Special Visa issued under these Regulations shall
  - 6. (1) A CARICOM Special Visa issued under these Regulations shall be in the form as set out in the Fourth Schedule and shall be issued on payment of the fee as set out in the Fifth Schedule.
  - (2) The fee referred to in sub-regulation (1) shall be payable to the Ministry of Home Affairs.
  - (3) The Minister shall authorise the payment of the CARICOM Special Visa fee to be utilised by IMPACS.

Revocation of CARICOM Special Visa.

- 7. (1) The immigration officer may revoke a CARICOM Special Visa if the holder-
  - (a) has made a false declaration in his or her application for a CARICOM Special Visa; or
  - (b) has committed any breach of any of the provisions

  - Where a CARICOM Special Visa of a holder is revoked under (2) sub-regulation (1), the immigration officer shall serve a notice of such revocation, on the other Member States.
  - If the CARICOM Special Visa that has been revoked under subregulation (1) was issued by a Member State for entry in Guyana, a copy of the notice of revocation shall be forwarded for the information of the authority responsible for immigration matters in that Member State.
  - (4) A CARICOM Special Visa may be cancelled by the immigration officer or the visa issuing authority of a Member State if the CARICOM Special Visa appears to have been issued in error.

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Where the travel document of an alien bears any valid visa issued by a Member State for entry into such State prior to the commencement of these Regulations, such visa shall be valid and acceptable for entry in Guyana as if such alien has been issued a CARICOM Special Visa for entry in Guyana.

- 9. (1) These Regulations shall not apply to an individual who is-
- a citizen, national or subject of any of the States. (a) Countries or Territories mentioned in the First is duration of slav to be granted Schedule: or
  - (b) entering Guyana from any place outside the territories of the Member States; or

- (c) in possession of a travel document issued to him by the relevant authority of his country of nationality.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions, the Minister may waive any requirement to hold a CARICOM Special Visa under these Regulations in respect of an alien and issue him an entry permit in the form set out in the Sixth Schedule if such alien is
  - (a) duly accredited to the Government of Guyana by or under the authority of the Head of State of any foreign Government or is a member of staff of any such alien; or
  - (b) in an advisory or in a consulatative capacity to Guyana on invitation by the Government or any organisation in Guyana; or
  - (c) a dependant of any of the persons referred to in paragraphs (a) or (b); or
  - (d) the spouse of any person referred to in paragraphs (a) or (b).
- (3) Where the Minister issues a permit under sub-regulation (2), the Minister shall serve a notice of such waiver on the Member States.

# Saving of existing rights.

- 10. These Regulations shall not affect-
  - (a) any right that has accrued under any written law or other agreement made by Guyana with any foreign State or Country or Territory; or
  - (b) the authority of the Immigration Officer to-
    - (i) refuse entry of a holder in the interest of national security; or
    - (ii) determine the duration of stay to be granted to an alien.
