

ANIMALS (MOVEMENT) AND DISEASE PREVENTION ACT 2003
(No.14 of 2003)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 24 OF
THE ANIMALS (MOVEMENT) AND DISEASE PREVENTION ACT 2003,
I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS: -

- Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Movement) and Disease Prevention (Sale of Chicks) Regulations 2008.
- Day old broiler to be vaccinated against H/H and Infectious Bursal disease. 2. The owners and operators of hatcheries shall not sell broiler baby chicks, which have not been vaccinated against Inclusion Body Hepatitis/Hydropericardium Syndrome (H/H) and Infectious Bursal Disease.”
- Day old layer to be vaccinated against Mareks and Infectious Bursal disease. 3. The owners and operators of hatcheries shall not sell layer baby chicks, which have not been vaccinated against Mareks and Infectious Bursal Disease.”
- Offences. 4. An owner or operator of a hatchery who contravenes regulation 2 or 3 commits an offence and shall be liable of summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months.
- Revocation. 5. The Animals (Movement) and Disease Prevention (Sale of Chicks) Regulations 2007* is revoked.
