

## REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, 1969  
(No. 15 of 1969)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON ME BY SECTION 51  
OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT,  
1969, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1971, and amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Questions) Regulations, 1969, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) by the addition of the following paragraph to regulation 7 as paragraph (4) thereof —

“(4) The Director may delegate to any officer of the Board the power to exercise on his behalf the functions vested in him by this regulation.”;

(b) by the substitution of the word “Director” for the word “Board” in paragraph (2) of regulation 16 and by the substitution of the word “he” for the word “it” where it last appears in the said paragraph (2);

(c) by the addition of the words “or a solicitor” after the word “barrister” in paragraph 2(1) of the Schedule.
