REGULATIONS MADE IN PURSUANCE OF THE IMPORTATION OF TEXTILES (QUOTAS) ORDINANCE, 1934.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Textiles (Quotas) Regulations, 1934. Short Title.

2. A return of the quantity, class and origin of any regulated textiles imported shall be made upon the appropriate import entry form. Return of regulated textiles imported.

3. A declaration of origin of any regulated textiles imported shall be in the form set out in the schedule to these regulations. Form of declaration of origin.

4. On payment of a fee of one shilling the Comptroller may furnish to any person a statement of the total quantity of regulated textiles already imported from any individual foreign country during any quota period. Payment of fee for statement.

Made by the Governor in Council under section 8 of the Importation of Textiles (Quotas) Ordinance, 1934, this 6th day of July, 1934.
