REGULATIONS TO AMEND THE RICE (EXPORT BLEND-ING AND GRADING) REGULATIONS, 1934.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rice (Export Blending Short Title. and Grading) Regulations (No. 3), 1934, and shall be construed with the Rice (Export Blending and Grading) Regulations, 1934, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and with the Rice (Export Blending and Grading) Regulations (No. 2), 1934.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting the following in the first, second and third columns respectively between the grades "Super" and "No. 1":—

Amendment to First Schedule of Principal Regulations. Grade added.

"No. 1 (Extra) | Not to contain more than a total of 25 per cent. of broken and discoloured grains.

Not below Super; guide per as sam ple."

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the first day of Commencement. October, nineteen hundred and thirty-four.
