REGULATIONS RELATING TO LATE FEES (ADDITIONAL POSTAGE) ON PACKETS HANDED IN AT THE G.P.O. COUNTER SUBSEQUENT TO THE ADVERTISED HOUR OF CLOSING OVERSEAS MAILS.

AMENDED TARIFF.

Effective: November 1, 1939.

The Late Fee Tariff printed on page 51 of the Current (1939) British Guiana Post Office Guide and printed on the Current Mail Notice (Post Office Form No. 60) is hereby amended by the insertion of the following intermediate scale between 30 and 90 minutes with effect as from November 1, 1939:—

Ordinary Postal Matter etc. within 60 minutes 12 cents.

The Tariff will read:—

LATE POSTING FEES.

EXTRA POSTAGE.

Ordinary Postal Matter: within 30 minutes ... 4 cents do : within 60 minutes ... 12 cents do : within 90 minutes ... 24 cents Registered Postal Matter: within 30 minutes ... 8 cents

AFTER the advertised hour of closing of an Overseas Mail.
