REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNTS PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF PILOTAGE FEES UNDER THE HARBOURS AND) PILOTAGE REGULATIONS, 1924.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours and Pilotage Short title. Temporary Surtax) Regulations, 1939 and shall be construed with the Harbours and Pilotage Regulations, 1924, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any amending Regulations.

2. In addition to the fees prescribed by Regulation 44 of the Imposition Principal Regulations, as amended by the Harbours and Pilotage Regulations, 1929, for services rendered by pilots, there shall be levied and collected during the year 1940, a surtax at the rate of fifteen per centum on every such fee : provided that the surtax shall fees. not be levied in the case of any vessel while proceeding to or from the Essequebo River for or with lumber.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement of January, Nineteen Hundred and Forty. Regulations.
