## BRITISH GUIANA.

## REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

## THE CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 171).

UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL:—

- 1. These Regulations may be be cited as the Crown Lands (Amendment) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Crown Lands Regulations, 1919, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
  - 2. Regulation 49 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended—
    - (a) by the insertion of the words "by prismatic compass and chain" after the word "inspection" in the fourth line thereof; and
    - (b) by the substitution of the following for the table of fees therein appearing—

" For inspection of an area up to 100 acres	\$25.00
For inspection of an area over 100 acres and	up
to 500 acres	30.00
For inspection of an area over 500 acres and	ир
to 1000 acres	60.00
For inspection of every additional 500 acres or p	art
thereof over 1000 acres	20,00"

- 3. The First Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby further amended—
  - (a) by the deletion of items 15 to 20 inclusive; and
  - (b) by the substitution of the following therefor—
    '' 15. For making any survey up to 10
    - 15. For making any survey up to 10 acres including diagram \$15.00

      16. For surveying each acre over 10 acres and
      - up to 40 acres.
      - 17. For surveying each acre over 40 acres and up to 100 acres .... .60
      - 18. For a survey of any area over 100 acres the applicant shall deposit additional fees at the following rates—:
        - (a) for each acre above 100 acres and up to 1000 acres .... .50
        - (b) for each acre above 1000 acres .... .25
          Provided that where the actual costs of surveying any tract above 100 acres exceeds the amount deposited, the

applicant shall pay the excess costs after survey, and similarly where the actual cost is less than the amount deposited the applicant shall be entitled to a refund of the difference.

Note.—(i) The fees for the services of a surveyor and party on survey work in the field shall be at the rate of \$30.00 a day. No fees shall be payable in respect of the days spent in travelling to and from the site of survey where the number of days so spent does not exceed 25 per centum of the number of days spent on work in the field. Any excess of days over the above percentage spent in travelling shall be charged for at the rate of \$30.00 a day. The expenses of transportation are not included in the above fees but are payable in addition.

(ii) The fees for the services of a surveyor in the office

shall be at the rate of \$6.00 a day.
