REGULATIONS MADE UNDER

THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE, (Chapter 196).

UNDER SECTION 57 OF THE EDUCATION ORDI-NANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:---

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Carnegie Trade School for Women (Amendment) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Carnegie Trade School for Women Regulations, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution of the following regulation for regulation 14 thereof—

"Ordinary vacations. 14. In addition to all Public Holidays the School shall be closed for two to three weeks at Christmas, two to three weeks at Easter and five to six weeks during the period July to September. These vacations may be changed to other periods at the discretion of the Board, so however that no change shall be made which would permit the School to be kept open continuously for more than four months."
