REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, (CHAPTER 185).

UNDER SECTION 94 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 4 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, 1935, THE FOL-LOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telephone (Amendment) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Telephone Regulations, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 30A of the Principal Regulations, as inserted by regulation 2 of the Telephone (Amendment) Regulations, 1946^* is hereby amended by the substitution of the following for sub-regulation (5) thereof—

"(5) Where an overseas telephone call involves a trunk call, a trunk call fee at the rate six cents a minute (or a part thereof) shall be paid for either an incoming or an outgoing call, with a minimum payment for three minutes :

Provided that no trunk call fee shall be payable for calls to or from the countries set out in List B of Schedule E."

3. Schedule E to the Principal Regulations, as inserted by regulation 3 of the Telephone (Amendment) Regulations, 1946, is hereby revoked and the following Schedule is substituted therefor -
