REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 196).

UNDER SECTION 57 OF THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN
MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Carnegie Trade School for Women (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Carnegie Trade School for Women Regulations, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the figures "14" for the figures "15" therein appearing.
