REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1940,

(No. 22 of 1940).

UNDER SECTION 77 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1940, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1953, and shall be read and construed with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations, 1948*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations

and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 162 of the Principal Regulations as amended by regulation 2 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations, 1950**, is hereby further amended by the substitution for the figures and word "30 persons" in the second proviso to paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (2) of the figures and word "39 persons."
