THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952,  
(No. 69 of 1952).

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION)  
ORDINANCE, 1952 THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS  
HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Customs Regulations, 1952\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 115 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words and figures "section 147", of the words and figures "section 146".

3. The proviso to paragraph (1) of regulation 151 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "hereon" of the word "thereon."
