REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE FORESTS ORDINANCE, 1953.

(No. 15 of 1953).

UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE FORESTS ORDINANCE, 1953, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Forests (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Forests Regulations, 1953, No. 38 of 1953 hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —
