REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE FIREARMS ORDINANCE, 1940,

(No. 11 of 1940).

UNDER SECTION 44 (1) OF THE FIREARMS ORDINANCE, 1940, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Firearms Regulations, 1940,* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The table contained in regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations as substituted by regulation 2 of the Firearms (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1951,* and amended by the Firearms (Amendment) Regulations, 1952,* is hereby further amended by the substitution for the words—

“The officer for the time being in charge of the police in the District”

where they appear in the second column thereof opposite the “The North West District” in the first column, of the following words—

“The officer for the time being in charge of the police in the District.

The officer for the time being in charge of the North West Amerindian District established under the provisions of the Amerindian Ordinance, 1951.”
