## REGULATIONS Made Under THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, (Chapter 132).

## UNDER SECTION 97 (1) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDIN-ANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Official Inland Correspondence (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Official Inland Correspondence Regulations, 1955\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any regulations amending the same.

2. The following regulation is inserted after regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations —

"Correspon-5A All inland correspondence, circulars and postal dence in relation to packets passing between the St. John Ambulance Brigade St. John and the St. John Ambulance Association and any person in Ambulance Brigade and relation to the business of those organisations shall be trans-St. John Ambulance mitted post free". Association to be transmitted post thee.
