REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE RIVER NAVIGATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 270).

UNDER SECTION 7(h) OF THE RIVER NAVIGATION ORDINANCE,
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE
COMMISSIONER OF LANDS AND MINES WITH THE APPROVAL
OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the River Navigation (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the River Navigation Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended—
(a) by renumbering the regulation as sub-regulation (1); and
(b) by the addition of the following sub-regulation —

“(2) No timber raft exceeding 80 (eighty) feet in length and 45 (forty-five) feet in width shall be steered, floated, moored or otherwise used in the Berbice River”.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1956.
