THE SUGAR INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUNDS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 248).

UNDER SECTION 9(1) OF THE SUGAR INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUNDS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE COMMITTEE APPOINTED TO CONTROL AND ADMINISTER THE SUGAR INDUSTRY REHABILITATION FUND, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sugar Industry (Rehabilitation Fund) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed with the Sugar Industry (Rehabilitation Fund) Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of the expression "rehabilitation" of the following new definition—

"rehabilitation" means the extension, renovation or reconstruction of any existing factory or ancillary building pertaining thereto, or the replacements or improvements to any existing plant or machinery in a factory, or the installation of any new plant, machinery, or engine in a factory for the purpose of increasing efficiency in production or for safeguarding any existing factory, but does not include normal maintenance;"
