## REGULATIONS MVade Under

## THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, (Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTIMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parcel Post (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Parcel Post Regulations *, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
2. Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the sulbstitution for paragraph (a) in the table of postage rates of the paragraph which appears in the schedule to these Regulations.
