THE SPECIAL REVISAL ORDINANCE, 1956,

(No. 9 of 1956).

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIO J 18 OF THE SPECIAL REVISAL ORDINANCE, 1956, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Revisal (Prescribed Hours) Regulations, 1956.,
 - 2. In these Regulations, "the Ordinance" means the Special Revisal Ordinance, 1956.
- 3. The sittings of the revising officers for the revision of the lists under the provisions of the Ordinance shall be from one o'clock to six o'clock in the afternoon on the day specified in the revision notice, and upon the day or days to which the revision has been adjourned.
- 4. Nothing in regulation 3 of these Regulations shall prevent a revising officer from sitting after six o'clock in the afternoon of any day, if he considers it necessary so to do.
- 5. Nothing in regulation 3 of these Regulations shall prevent a revising officer from ceasing his attendance before six o'clock in the afternoon of any day, if the business of the revision of the lists has been disposed of before that time.
