BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE. (Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one Cap. 309 with the Customs Regulations hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

"Drawback on local manufac-turers."

2. Paragraph 1 (c) of regulation 153 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor:---

(c) Subject to such conditions as the Comptroller may generally or in any particular case impose, drawback on imported materials on which duty has been paid shall be payable in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed in Appendix "E ?

3. The appendix to these Regulations is hereby inserted as Appendix E to the Principal Regulations.

APPENDIX

(Reg. 153 (1).)

- (i) Upon the exportation of garments from the Colony drawback in full of the duties paid on the importation of the cloth used in the making of such garments;
- Upon all other imported materials on which duty has (ii) been paid, which are used in the manufacture or packaging of articles manufactured or produced in the Colony, drawback shall be paid, on the exportation or use as stores of such articles, calculated at the preferential tariff rate of duty on such materials which the Comptroller is satisfied have been so used, notwithstanding that the general tariff rate may have been paid thereon.
