

BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS
MADE UNDER
THE LABOUR ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 193).

UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Cinema Employees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Cinema Employees) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any regulations amending the same.

2. (1) The definitions of the terms "First Run Cinema" and "Second Run Cinema" appearing in regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations are hereby deleted, and the following new definitions substituted therefor:—

"First Run Cinema" means any cinema in Georgetown or New Amsterdam which usually exhibits motion pictures not including Indian, Chinese or advertising films, for the first time;

"Second Run Cinema" means any cinema which is not a First Run Cinema."

(2) The definition of the term "constable" is hereby deleted and the following definition is inserted immediately after the definition of the term "general staff":—

"guard" means a person employed by the employer to preserve order or to watch over bicycles or other property of the patrons of a cinema."

3. The first schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "Constables" appearing therein, and by the substitution therefor of the word "Guards".
