## REGULATIONS

## MADE UNDER

## THE FACTORIES ORDINANCE

(Chapter 115)

UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE FACTORIES ORDINANCE THE FOL-LOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hours of Work (Saw Mill Workers) Regulations, 1956.
  - 2. In these Regulations
    - "saw mill worker" means any person employed to perform manual labour in connection with the operation of a saw mill; "saw mill" means any place where wood is prepared by mechanical process for building purposes.
- 3. The number of hours which may normally be worked by a saw mill worker in any week shall not exceed forty-four.
- 4. It shall be the duty of an employer to keep posted up in a conspicuous place on the premises of the saw mill one or more copies of these Regulations.
- 5. Any person who commits a breach of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence, and shall, upon summary conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty dollars.
- 6. The Hours of Work (Berbice Saw Mill Workers) Regulations, 1953\*, are hereby revoked.
