REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, (Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97(h) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Private Letter Boxes (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1956.
- 2. Regulation 5 of the Private Letter Boxes Regulations*, as amended by the Private Letter Boxes (Amendment) Regulations, 1956**, is hereby revoked, and the following substituted therefor:—

"5. The charges for letter boxes shall be payable annually on the 1st of January and shall be as follows —

(a) General Post Office, Georgetown —	
For a box of No. 1 size	\$ 9.00
For a box of No. 2 size	\$18.00
For a box of No. 3 size	\$27.00
(b) New Amsterdam Post Office —	
For a box of No. 1 size	\$ 4.50
For a box of No. 2 size	\$ 9.00
For a box of No. 3 size	\$13.50
(c) District Post Offices other than New Amsterdam —	
For a box of No. 1 size	\$ 4.50
For a box of No. 2 size	\$ 9.00
For a box of No. 3 size	\$13.50"

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st of January, 1957.
