REGULATIONS<br>Made Under<br>THE POS' AND TELEORAPH DRDINANCE, (Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION $97(h)$ OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH OROINANCE, THE FOLLIOWTNG REGUIATIONS HAVE BEEN MADFi BY THE POSTMASTER GENHRAT, WTHE TEE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may he cited as the Private Letter Boxes (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1951 .
2. Regulation 5 of the Private Letter Boxes Regulations*, as amended by the Private Letter Eioxes (Amendment) Regulations, 1956\%*, is hereby revoked, and the following substituted therefor:-
" 5 . The charges for letter hoxes shall be payable annually on the 1st, of Jannary and shall be as follows -
(a) General Post Office, Georgetown -

For a box of No. 1 size
\$ 9.00
For a box of No. 2 size $\$ 18.00$
For a box of No. 3 size
$\$ 27.00$
(b) New Amstexdam Post Office -

For a box of No. 1 size
\$ 4.50
For a box of No. 2. size
\$ 9.00
For a box of No. 3 size
\$13.50
(c) District Post Offices other than New Amsterdam -

For a box of No. 1 size
\$ 4.50
For a box of No. 2 size $\$ 9.00$
Far a box of No. 3 size $\$ 13.50^{\prime \prime}$
3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st of January, 1957.
