# THE RICE FARMERS (SECURITY OF TENURE) •RDINANCE, 1956.

#### (No. 31 of 1956).

UNDER SECTION 55 OF THE RICE FARMERS (SECURITY TENURE) ORDINANCE. 1956, THE FOLLOWING OF REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

These Regulations may be cited as the Rice Farmers 1. (Security of Tenure) Regulations, 1956.

In these Regulations — 2.

> "the Ordinance" means the Rice Farmers (Security of No. 31 cf Tenure) Ordinance, 1956; and 1956.

"schedule" means the schedule to these Regulations.

3. Every application made to an assessment committee under the provisions of the Ordinance shall be in writing signed by the applicant, and shall be addressed to the chairman of the assessment committee for the area within which is situate the holding which is the subject of the application. Each application shall be in the form set out as Form A in the schedule and shall include a description of the holding to which the application relates, setting forth as far as possible its situation, extent and boundaries.

4 On receipt of an application made in accordance with the preceding regulation, the notice required to be given by the committee to the tenant and to the landlord or his agent as the case may be under the provisions of the Ordinance shall be in the form set out as Form B in the schedule.

5 The certificate of the maximum rent issued by an assessment committee under section 18 of the Ordinance shall be in the form set out as Form C in the schedule.

6. Where there is an appeal from a decision of an assessment committee under the provisions of section 26 of the Ordinance the notice of appeal shall be in the form set out as Form D in the schedule.
