

BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS  
MADE UNDER  
THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 91).

UNDER SECTION 53 OF THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Government County Scholarships (Amendment) Regulations, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Government County Scholarships Regulations, 1957, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Paragraph (1) of Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor :—

“(1) Each scholar shall be entitled to free tuition for five years at an approved secondary school. The cost of tuition, including any additional charges approved by the Director of Education, shall be borne by Government.”

3. These Regulations shall take effect from the 1st January, 1960.
