REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE, (Chapter 91).

UNDER SECTION 53 OF THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOW-ING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Amendment) Regulations, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Secondary Schools Regulations, 1957*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. Paragraph (5) of regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "or otherwise fails to conform with" after the word "satisfies" appearing therein.
 - 3. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended
 - (a) by the renumbering of regulation 26 as regulation 27; and
- (b) by the insertion of the following regulation after regulation 25 —

 26. (1) An increase in school fees may only be effected as from the commencement of a school year and at no other time. Any such increase shall be subject to approval of the Director of Education being first obtained.
 - (2) An application for such approval which shall state the amount by which it is proposed to increase the school fees shall be made in writing not later than six months prior to the commencement of the school year at the commencement of which the increase is to become effective.
 - (3) Parents and guardians shall be informed of any increase in school fees for which the approval of the Director of Education has been obtained not later than the commencement of the term immediately preceding the school year at the commencement of which the increase is to become effective."
