REGULATIONS
MADE UNDER
THE RIVER NAVIGATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 270).

UNDER SECTION 7(1) (b) OF THE RIVER NAVIGATION ORDINANCE,
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE
COMMISSIONER OF LANDS AND MINES WITH THE APPROVAL OF
THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the River Navigation (Amendment) Regulations, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the River Navigation Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the River Navigation (Amendment) Regulations, 1956+, is hereby further amended by the addition after paragraph (2) thereof of the following paragraph:—

“(3) No timber raft exceeding 80 feet in length and 35 feet in width shall be steered, floated, moored or otherwise used on that portion of the Kaituma River between its mouth and its junction with the Sebai River.”
