REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 139).

UNDER SECTION 4 (2) OF THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR AND LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hospital Fees (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Hospital Fees Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The following paragraph is hereby added to regulation 13 of the Principal Regulations—

“(3) Notwithstanding anything in schedules I to VII hereto every public officer on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Colony, for whom any service mentioned in schedule VIII hereto is prescribed in a written recommendation addressed to a government medical institution by a medical practitioner, duly registered as such in the Colony, shall be entitled (whether as an in-patient or an out-patient) to receive gratuitously such service at any government medical institution which provides it and to which such recommendation is addressed as foresaid.”

3. The following schedule is hereby added at the end of schedule VII of the Principal Regulations—

“SCHEDULE VIII

Free services for public officers on the permanent and Pensionable establishment of the Colony.

X-ray examinations.

Operative Treatment.

Laboratory Services.”
