## THE PLANT PROTECTION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 245).

# UNNDER SECTION 16 OF THE PLANT PROTECTION ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Protection (Citrus Planting Materials) Regulations, 1961.

## 2. In these Regulations —

- "citrus planting materials" means the seed of any citrus fruit or the whole or any part of a growing or dying plant of the genus citrus-
- 3. Except as otherwise provided by these Regulations no citrus planting material shall be imported into the Colony.
  - 4. Nothing contained in these Regulations shall prohibit
    - (a) the importation of citrus planting materials by the Department of Agriculture; or
    - (b) the importation of any fruit of the genus citrus.
