REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE LABOUR ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 103).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Laundries Records Citation. Regulations, 1962.
 - 2. In these Regulations —

Interpretation.

"employee" means any person employed in a laundry; "laundry" means any place where persons are employed by way of trade or for purposes of gain in washing, ironing, pressing or dry cleaning of clothing, bed-linen or table-linen and on all duties incidental thereto; and also where any such persons are employed in any of the aforementioned duties incidental to any other trade or business.

3. (1) In every laundry, the employer shall keep a register (here-Register of inafter referred to as "the register") containing a record of the wages, wages, hours hours and conditions of work of his employees in the form set out in ions of work. the schedule to these Regulations.

(2) The register shall be produced on request for inspection by the Commissioner of Labour or the Deputy Commissioner of Labour,

or any Inspector or Assistant Inspector of Labour.

- (3) The register shall be kept from day to day and shall be kept-up-to-date.
- 4. Any person who commits a breach of regulation 3 of these offences. Regulations shall, on summary conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty-five dollars.
- 5. The Records (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Laundries) Revocation. Regulations, 1952*, are hereby revoked.
